Inspired by the larger than life landscapes and bright colors of the southwest and Mexican culture, Dorri Thyden’s artwork brings together a vibrant spectrum of color into every painting. Believing that “art washes away from the soul the dust of everyday life,” her paintings are never dark or moody and whether landscapes, still life or abstract, her work is representational with a creative perspective and meant to inspire positive results.
